The Sherwood Country Club Charitable Foundation—known to our community as **Sherwood Cares**—has made a far greater impact than we ever imagined when we began this journey. Since being granted our 501(c)(3) nonprofit status in 2013, and thanks to the extraordinary generosity of the Sherwood community, we have awarded more than **\$7.7 million** in grants to **64 local nonprofits**.

The tremendous success of our 2024 Golf and Gala events gala allowed us to do something remarkable once again—add a **Special Project Grant** cycle in addition to our standard two annual grant cycles.

In December, we were able to award an **additional \$434,000** in Special Project Grants. These grants funded specific needs our nonprofit partners could not otherwise address in 2024—projects that simply would not have happened without support from *Sherwood Cares*.

A Glimpse of the Impact

- A Safe Place for Teens: New furniture at a Boys & Girls Club addressed long-standing safety and functionality issues, creating a more welcoming, enjoyable space for teens to gather after school.
- Clearer Vision, Brighter Futures: A local free clinic purchased vision testing equipment, enabling comprehensive weekly eye exams for low-income, uninsured, and underinsured patients. In nine months, they served 111 unique clients with full exams and provided prescription glasses to 92 people who otherwise could not afford them.
- A Kitchen Filled with Hope: A domestic violence shelter remodeled its heavily used kitchen, providing
 a safe, functional, and empowering space for residents.
- **Reaching Food Deserts:** A food bank purchased a cargo van to bring nutritious food and diapers to rural families facing financial hardship.

These are not just projects—they are lives changed, opportunities created, and hope renewed. **None of this** would have been possible without the generosity, vision, and heart of the Sherwood community.

The Sherwood Country Club Charitable Foundation provides grants to organizations with demonstrated capabilities in providing high-quality programs. Grants can be used for capital improvements or campaigns, specific projects, and for general program expenses.

The Foundation provides grants to charities that:

- \checkmark Are 501(c)(3) charitable organizations.
- ✓ Serve children and families in addressing educational, medical, nutrition or safety needs.
- ✓ Provide significant services supporting the community within a 25-mile drive of Sherwood Country Club.
- Have a record of demonstrated program operating success and outcomes in providing their services. Please note, the Foundation does not provide grants to groups that operate primarily as fundraisers for other charitable organizations.
- ✓ Have a history of demonstrated efficient financial management and controls in providing their services.
- Are successful in raising funds from additional sources, particularly in their immediate communities.
- Agree to the Foundation's requirements for post-award financial and operational reporting, in addition to entering into mutual releases with us regarding the use of names, logos, and photos.


